3-5 Year Olds

Each project in this class will be based on a popular children's book. Art is such a wonderful tool for this age group to prepare them for their school years. Art promotes hand eye coordination, helps develop fine motor skills, and helps them to think outside of the box. These are only a few of the skills we will touch on. 5-7 Year Olds

Class size will be smaller in order to focus more on technique and individual expression through art. Mediums explored are painting, drawing, mixed media and sculpture.
